RACE COURSE ACCESS AND TICKETING INFORMATION

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

Uphill foot travel is not permitted within the ski area 24/7 during the operating season.

Parents and spectators may not walk uphill from the Base Area to race courses.

Risks, dangers and hazards exist at any time and at any place on the mountain as well as in and around the competition course. Slick surfaces and icy conditions exist.

Bridger Bowl Inc. and Bridger Ski Foundation does not and cannot guarantee your safety.

Use Caution.

Alpine Competitions:

Course workers are to access the course by skis or snowboard only.

Accessing the course by skis or snowboard is recommended. Parents and spectators, who are not skiers, may purchase a single round trip ticket for Virginia City Lift only to access Deer Park Chalet for \$5.00. Parents and spectators **may be** permitted to walk from Deer Park Chalet to the Hanton's Race course when the course finish is at the bottom of the race hill only. Parents and spectators may travel uphill along the hi-vis fence line of the race course only. Please stay tight to the fence line as skiers also use this area.

Skiers have the right of way. Use caution.

Courses that finish higher on the mountain are not accessible by foot travel above Deer Park Chalet. If Virginia City lift is not operable, there is no foot travel access to the race course or Deer Park Chalet.

Freestyle Competitions:

The course may only be accessed using alpine skis or snowboard. There is no foot travel access to Freestyle courses.

**DO NOT REMOVE MULTIDAY TICKETS FROM THE RACER'S SKI CLOTHING
UNTIL AFTER THE EVENT IS OVER!**

We do not allow tickets to be transferred between people and use our plastic ties as our security system to protect against fraud. For each ticket your team is issued you will be given one tie. Ties sometimes break and we will gladly replace these, but we do not look kindly on coaches, parents, or participants coming back the next day asking for another tie.

If it is necessary to move a ticket to another piece of clothing, the participant (NOT THE PARENT OR COACH) must come to the ticket windows with the ticket still attached. We will watch them remove the ticket and will give them a new plastic tie to re-attach the ticket to a new piece of clothing.
