

Whitefish Mountain Resort

Medical Plan

- Whitefish Mountain Resort Professional Ski Patrol Headquarters shares building space with the *Base Lodge Clinic* near the base of Chair 6 adjacent to the Base Lodge. It can also be accessed by auto at 3840 Big Mountain Road.
- The Base Lodge Clinic at Whitefish Mountain Resort is an URGENT care affiliate of North Valley Hospital. The clinic can provide care for patients who don't need an emergency department in addition to stabilizing and arranging transfers for serious illnesses and injuries. Patients receive care from board-certified nurse practitioners and board-certified physician assistants. North Valley Hospital is located in Whitefish, 10 miles from the Resort. For very severe trauma, Kalispell Regional Hospital is located in Kalispell 28 miles from the Resort.
- Additionally there is a ski patrol hut at the top of chair 2 a very short distance from all of the Whitefish Homologated Venues. A Patroller will be assigned to the event and will be available at all times. All requests for First Aid will be responded to by the Resort Professional Patrol assigned to the event.
- Evacuation from the venue will be via toboggan to Ski Patrol Headquarters, The Base Lodge Clinic, a waiting ambulance or helicopter as needed and weather allows.
- Requests for first aid on the venue can be made through the jury and/or other race officials. Resort Dispatch shall be notified via resort/event radios on Channel 1. First Aid outside the venue may be summoned by any Jury member or official with a radio, resort workers equipped with a radio or any lift terminal or by phone or by phone 406.862.2940.
