



Mammoth Mountain Race Training Camps Mammoth Mountain Ski Area 2009/2010

Mammoth Mountain is pleased to host Ski and Snowboard Race Training Camps for the 2009/2010 season. In order to accommodate all teams, Mammoth Mountain offers a race camp package that includes training space, lift tickets, and a variety of lodging and meals options which allows you to customize your camp to meet your teams specific needs. We offer you the following proposal to help you plan for your team's camp.

Training Facilities:

Long, full width training lanes and a variety of terrain allow coaches and athletes to focus on the fundamentals and technique for racers of all ages and ability levels. All training lanes are located at the Main Lodge Area of the Resort and are separate from the public. Mammoth also features some of the best terrain in the country, challenging freestyle skiers and snowboarders to bring their skills to the next level. Mammoth Mountain offers one of the longest winter seasons in the country and is known for exceptional spring conditions as well reliable early season snowmaking, making Mammoth the ideal place to hold fall and spring training camps.



Training Sessions & Lane Assignments

Training sessions are a minimum of two hours to a maximum of three hours. Training lanes and sessions are provided according to each team's size and needs to the best of the Race Department's ability and judgment, based on the prevailing conditions. The Race Department will conduct daily coach's meetings to determine each camps needs and to assign lanes and times. Preference for training lanes will be given to teams that are staying in a Mammoth Mountain lodging property.

Lift Tickets and Lane Fees

Each participant will need a lift ticket or Mammoth Season Pass to access the training lanes. Lift tickets are included in the package pricing. Individuals who have a Mammoth Season Pass will be required to pay a lane fee of \$10; the lane fee is included in the package price.

Additional lane fees of \$300 per group will be charged for groups not staying in a Mammoth Mountain Ski Area Lodging Property.

Ski/Wax Room

Each race camp staying in a Mammoth Mountain Ski Area Lodging Property will be given the use of a ski/wax room. Assignments will be determined by the Race Department based on the needs of the resort and all groups staying at Mammoth Mountain Ski Area Lodging Properties. Assignments will be given upon check in.

Additional Options

- Race Poles: Race poles are available for loan. This may be arranged through the race department on an individual basis.
- Salt: Bags of salt are available at \$7 per bag.
- Snowmobiles: Snowmobiles are available for \$125 per hour including an operator when conditions are suitable and space is available.



Lodging Options:

Mammoth Mountain Inn



One of Mammoth’s most popular lodging options; the Mammoth Mountain Inn is located directly across from the Main Lodge providing easy access to Mammoth’s training space. The Mammoth Mountain Inn offers both hotel rooms and a limited number of condominium style units featuring kitchens for those who wish to cook their meals.

The Mammoth Mountain Inn features the Sierra General Store, a coin operated laundry, fitness center, pool and Jacuzzi, movie rentals and complimentary internet access.

Lodging Details

- All lodging property assignments are done on a first come, first serve policy. Please note that the Mammoth Mountain Inn is the most popular lodging property and will sell out quickly
- All lodging reservations are made based on run of the house availability, specific room types can be requested but can not be guaranteed.
- Preference for lodging requests will be given to race camps participating in a meal plan.

Meals Options:

Breakfast and dinner are provided in the Mountain Side Grill located on the second floor of the Mammoth Mountain Inn. Lunch is provided in the Broadway Marketplace, located in the Main Lodge, where your team can choose from a variety of stations and use the Mammoth Resort Card, provided to you at check in, as a debit card at the cashier’s station. Available stations and menu items may vary; alternative meal options and location may be provided. The Race Camp Package is all-inclusive, unused meals are non refundable.

Pricing:

Race Camp Package pricing is based on the following criteria

- All rates are based on a minimum of 10 people per camp; camps with fewer than 10 participants will receive the same rates but camp will be handled directly with race department and call center.
- Pricing includes all day lift ticket, training facility, and use of ski/wax room and is inclusive of tax and tip.
- All rates are per person occupancy based on meeting the minimum occupancy for the room (one person per bed).
- Race Camps which do not stay in a Mammoth Lodging Property will pay an additional \$300 lane fee per group.
- Rates are based on age group:
 Adults: 19 years and over
 Youth: 13-18 years
 Child: 12 year and under
 MVP: Mammoth offers discounted rates to individuals who do not need a MMSA lift ticket regardless of age.

A Mammoth Mountain Group Sales Representative will contact you to help you finalize the details of your race camp package. To reserve your race camp package a signed contract and a deposit of \$500 is required. Hotel and Lane Space will not be confirmed until a signed race camp contract and deposit are received.

Full payment of the camp is required 14 days prior to your arrival date. A credit card number must be given to your group sales representative and will be charged upon check out if the final invoice is not paid.

Liability:

Certificate of insurance with general liability of \$2 million, release waiver for each athlete and signed indemnity agreement provided prior to first day of training.
